Frequently Asked Questions

What if we can't afford an instrument?

CONTACT US!- there are low-cost options for getting an instrument either from Music and Arts or using LISD-owned instruments (certain conditions apply). Do NOT let financial concerns keep your child from joining - we can, and WILL, always find a solution!!

Does band take a lot of time?

NOT REALLY. For a beginner, the requirement for home practice is LESS THAN 2 hours per week, there are only 6 required full-band rehearsals throughout the school-year, and 4 concerts.

Will band get in the way of making good grades?

NOT LIKELY. While the amount of hard work toward classes is determined by each individual, over the years we have found the majority of students in band actually do BETTER in all their other classes. Band helps create habits of excellence that carry over to a multitude of other activities.

Does a student need to have prior band or other musical experience?

ABSOLUTELY NOT!! While a background in piano or similar instrument can be helpful to a student's understanding of musical concepts, it is NOT necessary to have prior knowledge or training. Most of the students in the Creek Valley Band had no music training outside regular 5th grade music classes prior to coming to school here.

Is it possible to be in BAND, LEAP, and have a lot of Pre-AP classes?

YES! In fact, quite a few of our current band students participate this way AND a majority of those even participate in football, volleyball, basketball, etc. in addition to that.

Asthma? Braces? Is it possible?

ABSOLUTELY! There are accommodations available for practically every student interested in being part of the largest organization at Creek Valley Middle School. There are plenty of students in band that wear braces or have asthma. In fact, playing a wind instrument can be beneficial in the strengthening of the lungs.

Do students have fun in band?

YOU DECIDE...92% of beginning band students enroll for band AGAIN in 7th grade (compared to only 30% of art students who continue art classes and 27% of speech/drama students who continue in drama.)



Something to shout about...

Research shows that students enrolled in school band programs:

- on average score 89 points higher on their SAT tests,
- are more likely to attend college and receive their undergraduate degrees(96% do), and
- are more likely to receive music scholarship money for college than any other program on campus (including athletics)

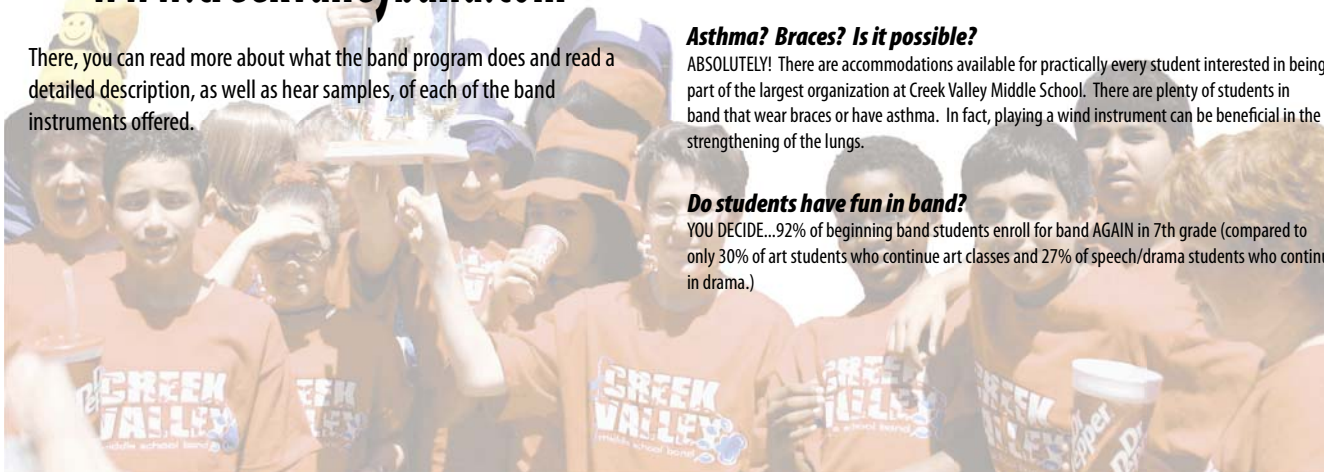
